CAMP CHAVERIM

Located at the Early Childhood Learning Center at Temple Israel, we offer a unique, nurturing and creative program for children 2.6* - 5 years of age. Skilled and caring teachers facilitate an outstanding program in our air-conditioned facility. Our Summer Program includes arts and crafts, sensory experiences, cooking, free play, music and movement, water and sprinkler play, outdoor activities and picnics on the playground. Children will also participate in weekly Shabbat celebrations and special theme days, known as "Wacky Wednesdays". Groups III through V will participate in a sports program run by Kids in Sports. They will also enjoy "Terrific Tuesdays" where a different surprise "specialist" will visit each week which may include Art Farm, Mad Science, Yoga, and many others. Four and five year olds will visit Central Park and enjoy other field trips. There will be a Family Picnic one time during the summer.

THE TADPOLES

GROUP II (Yellow Room): 2 year olds

Our GROUP II program is open to children age 2.6*-2.9 by June 1, 2009

Two year old children will experience a warm and intimate introduction to a nursery school classroom. Teachers will facilitate separation on an individual basis.

- 3 days: Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday – 9:00 – 11:00am

Three-year-old children will participate in a separated program in a warm, nurturing and creative setting. Our three year olds have two different enrollment options:

- 3 days: Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday – 9:00 –12:00pm
- 5 days: Monday – Friday – 9:00 - 12:00pm

Lunch: Children enrolled in the Group IV and V program will bring their own lunches. Snacks will be provided in all of our morning programs.

Registration / Enrollment: Camp Chaverim is open to the community at large. Enrollment will first be open to currently enrolled ECLC families and synagogue members through January 15th. After this date registration will open to the larger community. In the case of over-registration, children will be accepted on a first-come, first-serve basis. A minimum of two consecutive weeks is required to enroll.

Tuition: Weekly enrollment is offered, with a discount for enrollment in the four-week and eight-week programs.
